Hand cream products applied to the hands using the hands (palms), primarily leave-on	Class 5C
Baby creams, baby oils and baby talc	Class 5D
Products with oral and lip exposure	Class 6
Products applied to the hair with some hand contact	Class 7
Rinse-off products applied to hair with some hand contact	Class 7A
Leave-on products applied to the hair with some hand contact	Class 7B
Products with significant anogenital exposure	Class 8
Products with body and hand exposure, primarily rinse off	Class 9
Household care products with mostly hand contact	Class 10
Household care excluding aerosol products (excluding aerosol/spray/products)	Class 10A
Household aerosol/spray products	Class 10.B
Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate	Class 11
Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate without UV exposure	Class 11.A
Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate with potential UV exposure	Class 11B
Products not intended for direct skin contact, minimal or insignificant transfer to skin	Class 12



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
